The ITIL® 4 Specialist: High-velocity IT (HVIT) is one of the four modules to achieve the ITIL4 Managing Professional (MP) designation.

- Describe the key behavior patterns required for High-velocity IT environments

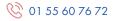

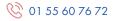

Multiple-choice format (1 mark per question)

Pass grade: 70% or 28 marks out of 40

40 questions Closed book

Duration: 90 minutes + 25 % extra time for non-native English Speakers

The exam is scheduled at the end of the 3rd training day in the classroom, or the participants can take the online exam later online and proctor-based. Candidates need to foresee ± 1.5 hours study time every evening to prepare the sample questions.
